



## Compliance Statement for AS/NZS 4777.2:2020 and AS60947.3:2018

EESS and SCO released their latest technical bulletin issued on Dec 14, 2021, regarding the compliance of inverters with inbuilt DC isolators. In summary, all GE branded inverters incorporating an integrated DC isolator now have eligibility to be listed with the CEC without a DC isolator certificate subject to the manufacturer providing a self-declaration form and subsequent test reports.

As a manufacturer of GE branded inverters, Goodwe has submitted relevant manufacturer self-declarations to the CEC on Dec 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The below listed models can now be installed (subject to CEC listing) regardless of whether the integrated DC isolator is registered on EESS as the Goodwe Manufacturer Declaration has been provided. Electrical Safety Regulators will not request proof of compliance until June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
